- ♥ Send out invites well in advance

- ♥ Maybe hold a quiz or raffle as part of your event.
- ♥ Make sure you have plenty of drinks in stock; you don't want to run out halfway through your evening!

- ♥ Wash up/load the dishwasher as you're going along. It will save on clutter and will save you a lot of hard work after dinner!
